

Memorandum of Understanding By and Between CCCFT and Cascadia College Regarding Visiting Scholar Teaching Opportunities

Whereas the College and the CCCFT share a mutual interest in global education and believe in providing educational experiences for our students that engage them fully in opportunities for connecting local and global understanding, and whereas both parties are committed to supporting and sustaining our existing Associate Faculty at all levels, and whereas providing the aforementioned educational experiences in a manner that respects contractual obligations to our Associate Faculty pool requires creative solutions, therefore, this MOU enables a Visiting Scholar, who meets the Minimum Qualifications for teaching at Cascadia, to teach up to two regular 11-week classes during one quarter under an Exchange Visitor Visa (J-Visa).

The Visiting Scholar would fall under the contractual procedures for a Probationary Associate Faculty, (e.g., class assignments would be made according to section 13.03.01.01) and the Visiting Scholar would be paid a stipend equal to the equivalent budgeted per credit compensation expense for a Probationary Associate Faculty.

The MOU is subject to ratification by the CCCFT and approval by the College President.
